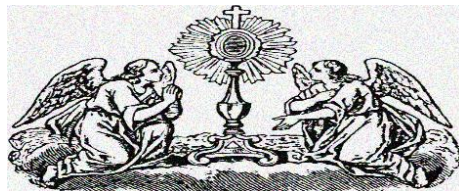
----- FROM THE PASTOR -----
